KOREAN FRIED CHICKEN

Korean fried chicken, globally loved, is double-fried for extra crispiness and served golden, seasoned, with tangy or spicy sauces for irresistible flavor.

SUNDUBU-JJIGAE

This spicy soft tofu stew features rich broth, tofu, seafood, vegetables, or meat, served bubbling hot alongside rice for a comforting Korean meal.

HAEMUL PAJEON

Haemul pajeon is a savory pancake made with a batter of scallions, seafood (such as shrimp or squid), and vegetables. It is pan-fried until crispy and enjoyed with a soy-based dipping sauce.



TTEOKBOKKI

Tteokbokki consists of chewy rice cakes stir-fried in a spicy gochujang sauce, often served with fish cakes and various vegetables. This popular street food dish packs a punch with its fiery flavors and addictive texture.



KIMCHI

Kimchi, Korea’s iconic side dish, is fermented cabbage or radish with spices—spicy, tangy, crunchy, and served with nearly every meal.
