


LOCAL CUSTOMS:


FESTIVALS (LỄ HỘI):



10 THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE TRAVELING TO VIETNAM

Before traveling to Vietnam, there are a few important things to know to ensure a smooth and enjoyable experience. Here are some key points to keep in mind:

RESPECT FOR CULTURE & CUSTOMS:

Respect local customs, traditions, and sacred sites. Dress modestly when visiting temples or shrines, and follow any guidelines or instructions given.

TRANSPORTATION:

Getting around Vietnam is part of the adventure. Ride-hailing apps like Grab, taxis, and cyclos are easy to use in cities. Trains, buses, and domestic flights connect major destinations.

Traffic can be hectic, especially in busy cities. When walking, cross slowly and steadily, and follow local habits. With a little patience, you'll quickly adjust to the rhythm of the road.

CURRENCY:

The currency of Vietnam is the Vietnamese Dong (VND). While credit cards are accepted in many places, it's advisable to carry some cash for small purchases, especially in rural areas or smaller shops.



4. VISA REQUIREMENTS:

Check if you require a visa to enter Vietnam based on your nationality. Make sure to obtain the necessary visa well in advance of your travel dates.

5. LANGUAGE:

The official language is Vietnamese. English is commonly spoken in tourist areas, but less so in rural regions. Learning a few basic Vietnamese phrases or using a translation app can greatly enhance your travel experience and interactions with locals.

6. WEATHER AND SEASONS:

Vietnam has a tropical climate, with warm, humid weather year-round. Conditions vary by region — the north has four seasons, while the central and southern areas are typically hot and dry or rainy. Check the forecast for your destinations and pack accordingly.

7. TIPPING:

Unlike in many Western countries, tipping is not mandatory but is appreciated for good service. In restaurants, rounding up the bill or leaving small change is common. For guides, drivers, or hotel staff, a small tip can go a long way and is always welcomed.

8. ETIQUETTE & CUSTOMS:

Respect for elders, modest dress, and polite behavior are valued in Vietnam. Remove shoes before entering homes, and dress modestly at temples. Use both hands when giving or receiving items, and ask before taking photos of locals.

9. INTERNET & CONNECTIVITY:

Free Wi-Fi is widely available. For better coverage, consider a local SIM or pocket Wi-Fi.

10. SAFETY & SECURITY:

Vietnam is generally safe, but take usual precautions. Keep valuables secure and consider travel insurance.

Banh Xeo

FRESH SPRING ROLLS

Light and healthy rice paper rolls filled with shrimp, pork, vermicelli, and herbs, served with hoisin-peanut dipping sauce.



PHO

Vietnam's most famous noodle soup, made with flat rice noodles, fragrant broth, and beef or chicken, garnished with fresh herbs, lime, and chili.



BANH MI

A crispy baguette sandwich filled with pickled vegetables, coriander, chili, pâté, and various meats. A delicious blend of Vietnamese and French influences.

BUN CHA

A Hanoi specialty featuring grilled pork patties and sliced pork belly served with rice noodles, fresh herbs, and a tangy dipping sauce.

COM TAM

Popular in southern Vietnam, this "broken rice" dish is typically served with grilled pork, shredded pork skin, egg meatloaf, and fish sauce.

CAO LAU

A unique noodle dish from Hội An, featuring thick noodles, roast pork, fresh greens, and crispy rice crackers, soaked in a savory broth.

BANH XEO

A crispy, turmeric-infused rice flour pancake stuffed with shrimp, pork, and bean sprouts, folded and eaten with fresh greens and dipping sauce.

CHA GIO

Crispy rolls filled with minced pork, mushrooms, and glass noodles, deep-fried to golden perfection and served with sweet-and-sour dipping sauce.

BUN BO HUE

A spicy and flavorful beef noodle soup from central Vietnam, known for its rich lemongrass-infused broth and thicker rice noodles.

CHE

A sweet dessert soup made from a mix of beans, fruits, jelly, and coconut milk. Served warm or cold, it's a refreshing end to any meal.



THE BEST TIME TO VISIT VIETNAM:



The best time to visit Vietnam depends on your destination and the kind of experience you're after. With its diverse geography, from cool mountain regions in the north to tropical lowlands in the south, Vietnam offers unique charms throughout the year.

Vietnam is generally warm and humid, with average temperatures ranging from 12–32°C in the north, 20–30°C in central regions, and 25–30°C in the south. Here's a quick seasonal guide by region:

| REGIONS | BEST TIME TO VISIT |
|-------------------|-------------------------|
| North Vietnam | Sep - Nov and Apr - Jun |
| Central Vietnam | Jan - Jun and Sep - Dec |
| Central Highlands | Nov - Apr |
| Southern Vietnam | Oct - Apr |

Tip: No matter the month, Vietnam promises rich culture, diverse landscapes, and unforgettable experiences. Just pack accordingly for the regions you'll visit!

HEALTH

You are advised to make an appointment with your doctor or travel clinic for a basic check-up at least six to eight weeks before you depart and find out if any vaccinations or health checks are required for your destination. Remember that some vaccines require a long period to take effect and more than one dose may be required.

You should make sure that your travel insurance covers all medical expenses for injuries or illness, as well as theft of valuables, damage to baggage and cancellations or interruptions to flight plans. Medical costs overseas can be in the tens of thousands of dollars and many people have been burdened financially in paying these costs when things go wrong. Recommended Medical Checklist: insect repellents, diarrhea medication, paracetamol, sunscreen, antiseptic and antibacterial cream.

TOP 10 MUST-VISIT ATTRACTIONS IN VIETNAM

Hue

Hue is a city of palaces and pagodas, temples and tombs, rich in culture and history. Once home to Vietnam's emperors, it houses the Imperial City — a former royal complex now partly restored. Though faded, its grandeur still offers a glimpse into Vietnam's imperial past.

Da Nang

Danang, nestled between three UNESCO Heritage Sites: Hue, Hoi An, and My Son — is a must-visit in Central Vietnam. With pristine beaches, historical relics, and a vibrant city life, it offers a perfect blend of tradition and modernity, warm hospitality, and charm — making it ideal even for honeymooners.

Mekong Delta

Known as the 'rice bowl' of Vietnam, the Mekong Delta is a landscape carpeted in a dizzying variety of greens and slashed with mighty waterways. It's a water world where boats, houses, restaurants and even markets float upon the innumerable rivers, canals and streams that flow through the region like arteries. At times you can quite simply lose sight of land.

Hanoi

Hanoi blends old and new Vietnam with Chinese and French influences, creating a captivating atmosphere. From the historic Old Quarter to Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum, there's much to explore. Enjoy local markets, tai chi, cooking classes, and great value on food and accommodation throughout the city.

Sapa

Established by the French in 1922, Sapa is a charming northwest town known for its stunning mountain views and cascading rice terraces. Even in mist, it captivates—especially during vibrant weekend markets, when local Hill-tribe communities bring colour and culture to this scenic highland destination.

Halong Bay

Halong Bay is known for its emerald waters and thousands of towering limestone islands topped by rainforests. Junk boat tours and sea kayaking expeditions take visitors past islands named for their shapes, including Stone Dog and Teapot islands. The region draws scuba divers, rock climbers and hikers, the latter favouring the mountainous Cát Bà National Park.

Nha Trang

Nha Trang is a picturesque coastal city known for its white-sand beaches, clear turquoise waters, and tropical climate. Its vibrant culture, fresh seafood, and laid-back charm attract many visitors. From island cruises to beach strolls, it's also a favourite destination for honeymooners in Vietnam.

Central Vietnam Highlands

Vietnam's Central Highlands offers stunning waterfalls, pine forests, and diverse ethnic cultures. Easily accessible towns anchor the region, though guided tours are needed for remote areas. With trekking, canyoning, rock-climbing, kayaking, zip lining, and more, it's fast becoming Vietnam's top destination for outdoor adventure and exploration.

Phu Quoc Island

One of Vietnam's newest tourist hotspots, this tropical island offers white-sand beaches, luxury resorts, and family-friendly activities. The southwest coast is lined with palm-fringed beaches, while over half the island is protected national parkland—home to dense jungle, mountains, and trails perfect for hiking, biking, and wildlife spotting.

Ho Chi Minh City

Ho Chi Minh City, formerly named Saigon, is the largest city in Vietnam. Discover the country's history by visiting the War Remnants Museum and Reunification Palace. Admire the French colonial architecture at the Federal Post Office, Opera House and Notre Dame Cathedral. From here you can explore the long maze of tunnels (Cu Chi) made by the Vietnamese people during the war.



WHAT TRULY MAKES VIETNAM A MUST-VISIT

Most travelers visit Vietnam for its stunning nature, from northern rice fields to the vibrant Mekong Delta. It also offers rich history and 8 UNESCO World Heritage Sites worth exploring.

IMPERIAL CITADEL OF THANG LONG HANOI

The central area of the Imperial Citadel of Thang Long-Hanoi is the archaeological site of Vietnam's ancient capital, founded in 1010, making it one of the oldest power centers.

CITADEL OF THE HO DYNASTY

The Citadel of Ho Dynasty are the remains of a late 14th century castle constructed from stone blocks. It was constructed by the Hồ Dynasty from 1397 and is a symbol of neo-Confucianism.

TRANG AN LANDSCAPE COMPLEX

The Trang An landscape complex is a visually spectacular mountainous karst area with numerous caves that have provided shelter to humans for 32,000 years.

HUE COMPLEX OF MONUMENTS

Huế was the Imperial Capital of Vietnam between 1802 and 1945. The Capital City is a complex enclosed within defensive walls. It holds residences, palaces and gates, with the Forbidden Purple City at its heart.

HALONG BAY

The Bay holds over 1,600 islands and islets. There are caves and grottoes, with stalactites and stalagmites. Its limestone pillars are a unique natural feature of great scenic beauty and ecological interest.

MY SON SANCTUARY

My Son Sanctuary was the religious centre for the capital of the Champa Kingdom. The majority of it was built in the 10th century and lies in a valley surrounded by mountains. Ambiance.

HO AN ANCIENT TOWN

Hoi An is a traditional trading port in South-East Asia. It is the result of a fusion of cultures over time, from the 15th - 19th century. Its architecture is of traditional Vietnamese design, with Chinese and Japanese influences.

PHONG NHA - KE BANG

The site includes Phong Nha Nature Reserve and Ke Bang forest, known for 300 caves spanning 126 km, including one of the world's longest underground rivers.
